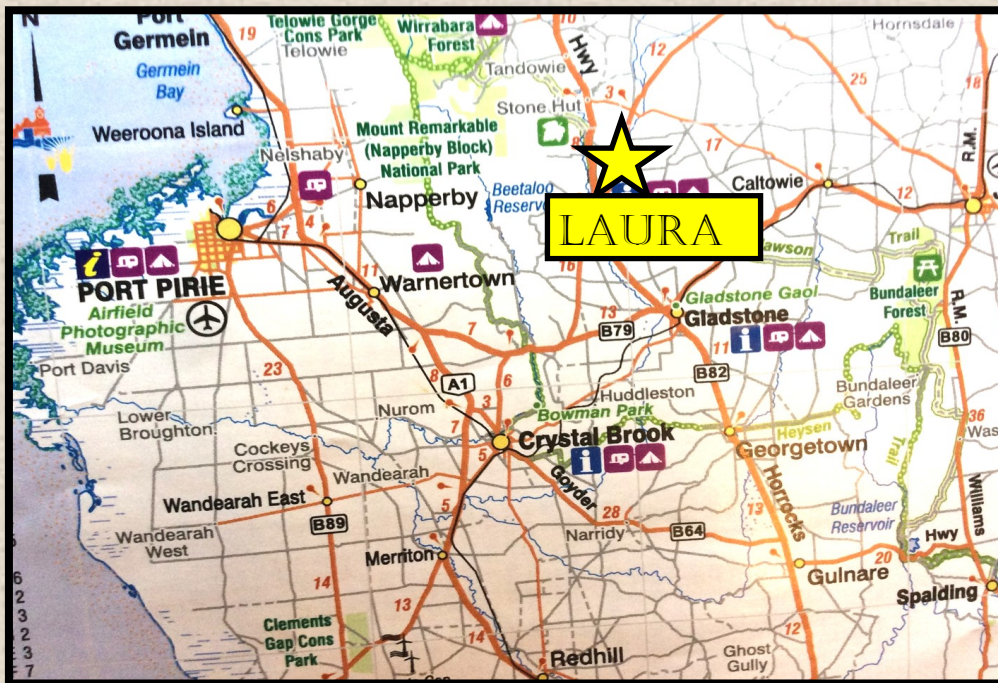

JAMES BLUNDELL was born in Stant-horpe

QLD , in 1964 . He was named “best new talent” at the 1987 Country Music Awards of Australia, which has led him into winning dozens of awards , and releasing many albums ,over the last 30 years. He was named 2019 inductee into the Australian Country Music Hall of Fame , his career in performing, songwriting and narrating television programmes spanning 32 years. He has rebirthed his career , starting in 2015 with the album “Come On In”, the following year he recorded “Campfire”. The album was inspired by a conversation with his collaborator and label head Karen Waters , when talking about Bruce Springsteens album “Nebraska”, allowing the stories in the songs to shine through. He truly is a legend in our Australian Country Music scene.



John released his first album in 2004 and since then has six albums to his credit. If Stones Could Talk, Old Rusty Ute, Storyteller, This Old Guitar, Flinders Ranges Magic and Happy Days showing that he is a natural performer, doing shows in all parts of Australia. He's received the Frank Harding award of Excellence at Barmera Country Music Festival twice, in 2005 and 2006.. John's third album Storyteller gained him a finals nomination in Heritage Song of the Year in the 2010 Southern Stars Australian Independent Artists Awards at Mildura for one song “ Where The Outback Starts” He is a retired farmer, and is based in Orroroo, teaching music to students and entertaining tourists.
